
Marlin, he is Nemo's father, who attempts to rescue him. Voiced by Albert Brooks.

The toys are welcomed by Lotso Bear but sooner they discover that the children mistreat them. Further, they are imprisoned in the daycare by Lotso and his gang. But Woody discovers the intention of the evil bear and returns to the daycare to organize the escape of his friends.
