When he grew up he beacame a host of Animal Planet’s series “The Crocodile Hunter”. He was a big star on cable network for ten years.


He also ran the family business after his parents, The Park in 1991.

By the time it stabbed his heart he died from it.

A national Momorial was planed for Steve Irwin and many of his

fans came to attend his funeral. More than five thousands people attened the Momorial Service in Queensland at Crocoseum stadium.
